O R D E R

This special leave petition has been filed against the order of the High Court rejecting anticipatory bail application No.412 of 2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the main allegations are only against accused Uttam Jadhav and petitioner has no concern with the alleged act. He submits that petitioner was not present at the time of alleged crime.

We are of the view that petitioner is not entitled to grant of anticipatory bail. However, it is open for the petitioner to surrender and make an application for regular bail, which shall be considered by the court concerned expeditiously without being influenced by the observations made by the High Court in the impugned judgment. It shall be open for the petitioner to make all submissions while pressing his bail application.

With these observations, the special leave petition is disposed of. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
