O R D E R

1. Issue notice.
2. Mr. D. Abhinav Rao, learned Advocate-on-Record, has entered appearance on behalf of the sole respondent, Botta Naga Chiranjeevi Reddy.
3. Leave granted.
4. During the course of hearing, learned counsel for rival parties were agreed, that the instant appeal be disposed of, by setting aside the impugned order dated 23rd November, 2016, passed by the High Court of Judicature at Hyderabad, by recording the undertaking of the appellants, that they would not alienate the suit scheduled property during the pendency of proceedings before the arbitral tribunal.
5. The aforesaid statement has, in fact, been made by the learned counsel for the appellants, having obtained instructions from the appellants.

6. In view of the above, the instant appeal is disposed of, by setting aside the impugned order dated 23rd November, 2016, and by substituting in place thereof the undertaking given by the appellants. The appellants would not alienate any of the suit property, during the pendency of the arbitral proceedings.

7. Pending applications stand disposed of.
