UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The present Special Leave Petition arises out of the impugned interim order dated 11.03.2019 passed by the High Court. The main

Writ Petition is pending before the High Court. The impugned interim order passed by the High Court has been stayed by this Court, vide earlier order dated 02.07.2019, which has been continued till date.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Union of India has submitted that, as such, in view of the subsequent development and the new enactment (National Commission for Indian System of Medicine) governing the recognition the Writ Petition has also become infructuous.

Let the aforesaid aspect be considered by the High Court as and when the main Writ Petition is taken up for further hearing. However, considering the fact that the impugned interim order passed by the High Court has been stayed by this Court and the stay has been continued till date, we dispose of the present Special Leave Petition directing to continue the interim stay granted by this Court, granted vide order dated 02.07.2019, till the final disposal of the main Writ Petition before the High Court.

In the facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the subsequent development and the new Act in force, we request the High Court to take up the main Writ Petition for further hearing within a period of eight weeks from today.

With this the present Special Leave Petition stands disposed of. Pending applications also stand disposed of.
