We have heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and perused the record.

We are afraid any mandamus can be issued directing the government/Medical Council of India (MCI) to lower down the percentile. Though Rule permits the government in consultation with the MCI to lower down the percentile, it is ultimately for the government/MCI to take appropriate decision to lower down the percentile. However, no mandamus can be issued directing the government/MCI to lower down the percentile.
