O R D E R

Leave granted.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

These appeals take exception to the judgment and orders dated 04.09.2020 and 25.02.2020 passed by the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission at New Delhi in IA/4340/2020 in FA/481/2020 and IA/18339/2019 in FA/2221/2019 respectively, whereby the commission has passed conditional order in favour the appellant(s); the condition being the appellant(s) shall deposit entire awarded amount with updated interest.

When these appeals came up for admission on 02.11.2020, the court passed the following order:

"Issue notice subject to the condition that 50% of the entire decretal sum along with interest component shall be deposited by the petitioner(s) in the Registry of the National Commission within four weeks from today.

Notice shall be issued by the Registry only after proof of deposit is filed within five weeks from today. In case, no proof of deposit is filed, the special leave petition shall stand dismissed without further reference to the court.

Subject to above, tag with Special Leave Petition No. 6554/2020."

In terms of the aforesaid order, the concerned appellant(s) have already deposited 50% of the entire decretal amount along with interest component. That is not in dispute.

The amount deposited before the Commission can be disbursed/invested by the Commission, subject to hearing both parties on such terms and conditions, as may be necessary.

Suffice it to observe, that in the interest of justice, these appeals need to be disposed of by confirming the interim arrangement noted in order dated 02.11.2020, referred to above.

Since the appellant(s) have complied with the said condition, the interim relief to continue, until the

disposal of the appeals pending before the Commission.

In addition to the liberty to withdraw the amount, it will be open to the respondent(s) to approach the National Commission for further relief in the event of any apprehension of possibility of appellants' defeating the final decree. That application be considered on its own merits.

Further, the respondent(s) may request the National Commission to take up the main appeal expeditiously, in the peculiar facts of the present case.

The appeals are disposed of, in the above terms.
