



We have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel for the respondents. We are of the opinion that the petitioner did everything within its powers to see that that the recognition is granted for the academic year 2020-21 by the cut-off date, but this could not take place in view of the laxity of the authorities. Recognition, therefore, ought to have been granted not only for the academic year 2021-22, but also for the academic year 2020-21 as well.

This being the case, whatever other permissions are required, including an NOC by the State Government, must follow upon our Judgment and be given within a week from today, so that the process for the academic year 2020-21 is no longer delayed.

The writ petition is disposed with the above terms.

W.P. (C) No. 1073/2020

On 07.07.2015, an application was made for recognition to B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed course run by the petitioner-college and all the teaching staff were in order by 31.12.2019.

On 27<sup>th</sup>/28<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 and 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2020, by the Minutes of Meetings of the WRC, recognition was granted for this course for the academic year 2021-22.
