We are not inclined to interfere in this special leave petition especially because of the concession of the Advocate for the petitioner recorded in the impugned judgment.

Counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the concession is wrongly given by the Advocate. For, the petitioner is in possession of

relevant revenue records and on which he intended to rely upon before the High Court, as he could not produce the same before the trial Court.

Therefore, the petitioner intends to move the High Court by way of a review with application to permit him to bring additional evidence on record. Whether such application is maintainable or otherwise is a matter to be examined by the High Court. We are not expressing any opinion on the merits of that request.

This special leave petition is, therefore, dismissed but limited liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the High Court for appropriate relief(s), if so advised.
