O R D E R

By the impugned order, the High Court has refused anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. This Court, by order dated 28.09.2020,

while issuing notice, has directed that no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner.

We have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned senior counsel for the complainant and learned counsel for the State.

After the learned counsel for the parties and after taking note of the order of this Court in *Satender Kumar Antil v. Central Bureau of Investigation and Another* (2021) 10 SCC 773 and more particularly, taking notice of the guidelines contained in Category A(e), we dispose of the petition as follows:

Interim order of protection will continue for a period of three weeks from today. We leave it open to the petitioner to point out to the Court before which the chargesheet has already been filed that he may be granted bail in terms of the guidelines which have been laid down.

The special leave petition is disposed of as above.

Pending applications stand disposed of.
