Upon perusal of the impugned judgment and order passed by the High Court, it appears that for this academic year 2019-20, according to learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Medical Council of India(MCI), MCI did not give any concessions which was given earlier. Therefore, as such the High Court has rightly dismissed the writ petition.

However, at the same time, it will be open for the petitioners who approached the MCI, can make a request which was made before the High Court and it will be open for the MCI to consider the same

as it is reported that all the seats are not likely to be filled up and number of seats are still vacant even after the last counselling.

With the aforesaid observations, the special leave petition is dismissed.
