UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

SLP(C)....D.No.20004/2019 :

Permission to file SLP is granted.

By an order dated 17.5.2019 passed in SLP(C)Nos.12430-12431/2019, this Court modified the judgment and order of the High Court impugned in the present special leave petition, by accepting the suggestion that one post be increased in the respective State cadres to be adjusted in coming years and to accommodate the 20 trainee officers who had approached this Court. This Court made it absolutely clear that accommodation was being made as an exceptional case and would not be treated as a precedent for other candidates of the same batch or in future, as only those 20 persons had approached the Court/Tribunal in time. With these observations, the special leave petition was disposed of.

The question of allocation of cadres cannot be reopened. It may be noted that the concerned trainees have completed their training and many of them been posted to the respective States.

The special leave petition is, therefore, dismissed along with all pending applications.

W.P.(C)No.753/2019 :

In view of the order passed today in SLP(C)....D.No. 20004/2019, we are not inclined to entertain this writ petition.

The writ petition is dismissed. Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of.
