UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

We have heard learned Counsel for the parties.

It is informed to this Court that the Criminal Revision Petition No. 1643/2015 came to be decided by the Single Judge of the High Court vide order dated 06.04.2017 and other Criminal Revision Petitions arising out of the same common order were delinked and they are still pending before the High Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that these appears to be cross-revision petitions against framing of charge and also the order of discharge passed by a common order dated 20.11.2015.

After we have heard learned counsel for the parties, we are of the considered view that all the Revision Petitions must have been heard together and disposed of by a common order.

The order impugned dated 06.04.2017 in the present Special

Leave Petition, in the light of what has been observed by us is, accordingly, set aside and Criminal Revision Petition No. 1643/2015 is restored on the file of the High Court and all Revision Petitions for which reference has been made by the High Court in its order dated 09.02.2017, i.e. Criminal Revision Petition Nos. 4396/2016, 162/2016 and 1433/2016 are directed to be tagged along with the Criminal Revision Petition No. 1643/2015.

We request the High Court to hear the Revision Petitions as expeditiously as possible, but in no case later than four months.

The parties are at liberty to raise their objections/submissions in the pending Revision Petitions.

With these observations, the Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of.
