This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of divorce case being M.C. No.66 of 2016, titled "*Venkatesh vs. Pushpa*", pending before the court of Family Judge at Kalaburagi, Karnataka, to the court of Civil Judge, Senior division, Navi Mumbai, Thane, Maharashtra.

Despite service of notice, respondent has not appeared. Hence, averments made in the transfer petition remain unrebutted.

In view of the above and also considering the hardships which will be faced by the petitioner in contesting the case at Kalaburagi, Bangalore, we deem it proper to allow the transfer petition and transfer the aforesaid case from the court of Family Judge at Kalaburagi, Karnataka, to the court of Civil Judge, Senior division, Navi Mumbai, Thane, Maharashtra, along with all records for its adjudication.

After transfer of the case, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour either for amicable settlement or for early decision in the case without unnecessary adjournments.
