UPON hearing the counsel, the Court made the following
O R D E R

SLP(CIVIL) No. 18719 OF 2017:

1. After addressing arguments for some time, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner seek leave to withdraw the present petition, while reserving the right of the petitioner to approach the controlling authority for appropriate relief.

2. Without making any observations on the merits of the pleas taken in the present petition, leave, as prayed for, is granted.

3. The petition for Special Leave to Appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.

WRIT PETITION (CIVIL) NO. 994 OF 2017:

1. We decline to entertain the present petition filed by the petitioner invoking Article 32 of the Constitution of India, particularly, when the petitioner has an equally efficacious alternative remedy of invoking Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

2. The petition is, accordingly, dismissed with liberty granted to the petitioner to seek appropriate legal recourse before the High Court.

3. It is made clear that this Court has not made any observations on the merits of the pleas taken in the present petition, which are left open for adjudication before the High Court.
