The Court is convened through video conferencing.

This special leave petition is preferred by the party in-person whereby he has been declined time by the High Court to pay the ad valorem court fee of Rs.1,19,800/- (less the amount that he has already paid) on the ground that in spite of sufficient opportunity was given to him by the trial court, he has not paid ad-valorem court fee.

The petitioner in-person is not present in the virtual court hearing. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order.

The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case the petitioner is granted six months' time from today to pay the court fee either in lump sum or in installment as the Trial Court may direct.
