O R D E R

Delay condoned.

Despite a finding recorded by the Labour Court that the termination was illegal and though the reinstatement was rightly denied the compensation has been fixed only at Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand).

In similar cases, we find minimum amount of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twentyfive Thousand) was fixed by way of compensation. For that purpose, we do not think a notice is required to be issued to the respondents. Therefore, it is made clear that the petitioner shall be entitled to one time compensation of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twentyfive Thousand) which includes Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten

Thousand) already granted by the Labour Court.

We direct the respondents to disburse this amount to the petitioner within three months from the date of production of a copy of this order.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
