O R D E R

The petitioners are aggrieved since their experience as Block Resource Persons is not treated as equivalent to the experience as teacher for the purpose of Head Teacher Class III.

According to the petitioners, they are also eligible and liable to be considered for the purpose of appointment as a Teacher, taking into account their service as Block Resource

Persons.

Whether the same is equivalent to experience as teaching or what are the qualifications required for the purpose of appointment as Head Teacher are all matters for the Competent Authority to decide.

Petitioners pray for an opportunity to make an appropriate representation before the Competent Authority. Permission granted, in which case, the representation may be considered on its own merits expeditiously and preferably within three months thereafter.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

We make it clear that we have not considered the special leave petition otherwise on merits.
