O R D E R

The prayer made by the petitioner - wife in the instant petition, *inter alia*, is as follows:

“(a) transfer the HMA/626/2020 titled as “Amanpreet Singh Vs. Mrs. Suruchi Kaur”, pending in the court of Ld. Principal District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, Haryana to the competent court at Raipur, Chhattisgarh.”

Having heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner - wife as also learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent - husband, we see no reason why we should not grant the relief as sought for by the petitioner- wife.

The Transfer Petition is, accordingly, allowed and HMA/626/2020 titled as “Amanpreet Singh Vs. Mrs. Suruchi Kaur”, pending in the Court of Principal District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, Haryana is ordered to be transferred to the Court of District Judge, Raipur, Chhattisgarh, who may try the case

himself/herself or make it over the same to any other Court of competent jurisdiction.

The transferee Court will make an effort for reconciliation between the parties.

The Registry will immediately communicate this order to the transferee Court for effecting compliance.
