O R D E R

The present proceedings arise out of the order passed by this Court dated 20.01.2020 by which, while dismissing the Special Leave Petition filed by the respondents-herein, this Court granted six months' time to the respondents to vacate the suit premises, subject to filing usual undertaking in the Registry of this Court. Thereafter, no further undertaking has been filed. The decree against the respondents has attained the finality.

From the office report, it appears that the respondents are avoiding execution of the bailable warrant directed to be issued by this Court. It is reported that the premises in question is locked.

In that view of the matter, we dispose of the present contempt proceedings by permitting the petitioner to get the possession of the disputed property in question by breaking open the lock, which shall be in the presence of the local S.H.O. and the local S.H.O. to prepare the *panch nama* of the property in question. If any movable properties are found in the property in question, the same may

be kept with the concerned P.S., Ferozepur City so that ultimately if anybody claims the same, the same can be given to the respondents on an appropriate application filed by them.

With this, the present contempt proceedings stand disposed of.
