



The limited grievance that needs to be placed on record is that the High Court passed a general order in a *suo motu* proceeding to permit the investigating agency not to produce the accused persons before the Court either in person as well as through video-conferencing. The issue raised is, wherever and whenever, production of accused parties via video-conferencing is permissible and possible, the investigating agency must endeavor to do so. We find force in this submission.

It will be open to the petitioner to impress upon the High Court to pass appropriate orders on future dates.

For the time being, the order referred to governs the period which is already over.

Hence, we give liberty to the petitioner to raise this issue before the High Court for future cases.

The special leave petitions are disposed of accordingly.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
