We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

This appeal has been filed against the order dated 20.02.2018 passed by the High Court in Criminal Revision No. 519 of 2011 by which the High Court dismissed the criminal revision filed by the appellant against order dated 25.06.2011 passed by Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate cum Special Judicial Magistrate, CBI, Ranchi rejecting the application for discharge.

Learned counsel for the appellant in support of the appeal raised various submissions including the submission that the Bank Manager- Shri Pradhan having not been charged the allegation of conspiracy under Section 120B IPC is not made out. It is further submitted that the charge under Section 420 is completely dependent on Section 120B of the IPC.

The learned ASG appearing for the respondents submits that in the present case evidence and arguments of the prosecution have already been completed and it is only the appellant's submissions which are yet to be considered by the Court below.

At this stage, when the evidence is completed and the

arguments of the prosecution have also been completed and the submissions of the appellant are yet to be considered, it will be appropriate that the Trial Court may take a final decision in the trial after considering the submissions which are being sought to be raised in this appeal and the submissions which are to be raised in the Trial Court.

In above view of the matter, we close the appeal leaving all the contentions of the appellant open.
