ORDER

- 1 These appeals, purportedly under Section 62 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code 2016, have been instituted to challenge a judgment dated 14 August 2020 of the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal¹ in Company Appeal (AT) (Insolvency) No 452 of 2020².
- 2 The appellants were not parties to the judgment which is sought to be challenged. The appellants' grievance is that they have been ousted from the Committee of Creditors by placing reliance on the above decision. This would not justify the appellants in filing an appeal against the judgment of the NCLAT in another case to which they are not parties. The appellants would have to pursue their own remedies against the decision of the Committee of Creditors to oust them. Hence, the appeals, as they are filed, are not maintainable. The appeals are dismissed. However, the appellants would be at liberty to pursue such remedies as are open in law.
