O R D E R

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, the averments made in the transfer petition, and in the interest of justice, we allow the transfer petition.

Accordingly, Divorce Petition No.265 of 2019, titled "*Gaurav Kasera vs. Anita Bhalia*", pending before the Family Court, Kota, Rajasthan is directed to be transferred to the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, Haryana, who may hear the case himself or assign it to a court of competent jurisdiction.

Records of the case would be immediately transferred to the transferee court.
