



preferred by the State were dismissed by the High Court vide order dated 28.07.2020.

Insofar as the present petition is concerned, we see no reason to interfere. The SLP is dismissed.

This order shall not however, have any impact if the State wishes to challenge against the dismissal of its WPMS No.2180/2018. Such challenge will naturally be considered on its own merits.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
