Mr. K.M. Natraj, learned Additional Solicitor General, points out that counter affidavit has already been filed. The Registry to ensure that the same is circulated along with paperbook on the next date of hearing. The rejoinder affidavit may be filed within two days from today.

Pursuant to the request sent to the Director, AIIMS, New Delhi vide order dated 27.09.2021, the report dated 01.10.2021 has been received and the same is taken on record. The relevant part of the report reads thus:-

".... The petitioner is a diagnosed case of Diabetes Mellitus, Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. Hypertension, Coronary Artery Disease, Carpal Tunnel Syndrome and Depressive illness. At the point of current assessment, the petitioner is in a stable medical condition on treatment. He requires regular, periodic follow up with the respective specialists on an outpatient basis for his ongoing conditions. There is no indication for his hospitalization as on date."

The question whether the petitioner needs to be granted relief because of health ground, can be considered on the next date.
