O R D E R

We have heard the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner and perused the impugned order passed by the High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad.

We do not find any good ground to interfere in the said impugned order passed by the High Court.

Learned senior counsel has stated that in the case of other co-accused, the High Court has granted liberty that "48 hours' notice shall be given to them for effecting their arrest" and the same protection be granted to the present petitioner also.

In case during the course of enquiry, his custodial interrogation is required, 48 hours of notice shall be given for effecting the arrest of the petitioner herein.

The special leave petition is dismissed with the aforesaid observation.
