O R D E R

1. On 23.09.2025, this Court had passed the following order:

1. Perused the records placed before us. Thus far, we have been of the considered view that it would only

be in the interest that the Chairman of the District Legal Services, Rohtas, Bihar interacts with the petitioner and submits a report in a sealed cover indicating (a) the health (Mental and Physical both) of the petitioner (b) with whom she is currently residing; (c) as to whether she is comfortably & safely residing at the said place.

2. Report be submitted within a period of four weeks.

3. The copy of the order be immediately sent to Registrar General of High Court of Patna. The matter be also brought to the notice of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High Court of Judicature at Patna for necessary compliance.

4. The particulars of the victim be sent to the Registrar General in a sealed cover. 5. List the matter on 04.11.2025."

2. In compliance of the said order, Report in a sealed cover is received from the High Court of Judicature at Patna.

3. We have perused the Report and the same is directed to be re-sealed and kept on record.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and having perused the report, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order dated 08.02.2024 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Patna.

5. The Special Leave Petition is dismissed.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
