O R D E R

- 1 The grievances which the petitioner raises, in our view, cannot be addressed in the form of a petition under Article 32 of the Constitution.
- 2 The petitioner, who appears in person, states that he has visited a number of public hospitals, but, has been unable to obtain adequate treatment.
- 3 Having regard to the nature of the grievances and on hearing the petitioner in person, we are of the considered view that it would be appropriate if the petitioner seeks medical advice at VIMHANS Nayati Superspecialty Hospital, Lajpat Nagar, Delhi.

- 3 We request the authorities of the Hospital, should the petitioner seek medical advise, to provide it. Since the petitioner states that he has no resources to do so, a compassionate view may be taken so that he can be duly attended to, should he be willing to submit to competent medical advise.
- 4 The petition is disposed of.
- 5 Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
