O R D E R

Issue notice.

Mr. Sriram P., learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondent-Caveator accepts notice.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the parties that they are willing to explore the possibility of mediation. The parties are, therefore, referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre.

The Supreme Court Mediation Centre shall appoint a mediator who shall first convene a meeting of the parties virtually. The first such meeting shall take place on 22.10.2021 at 2.00 P.M.

To enable the Mediator to establish contact with the parties, the learned counsel on both sides shall file a memo within two days indicating the mobile phone numbers and the e-mail addresses of the parties. If the Mediator is convinced that the parties are genuinely interested in mediation, the mediator may call both parties, thereafter, for physical negotiations. The report of the mediation shall be filed within eight weeks.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner-husband shall, without prejudice to the rights and contentions of either party, pay an ad hoc amount of Rs.10,00,000/- to the petitioner-wife.
