We see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the High Court has granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner - accused subject to showing the proof of the deposit of Rs.13,50,0034/-, with the Deputy Commissioner, Giridih.

Learned counsel further submits that the impugned order is liable to be set aside to the extent of imposition of condition to deposit Rs.13,50,0034/- for the anticipatory bail of the petitioner as the same is harsh and extreme and his client has not given any consent before the High Court to deposit the said amount.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to approach the High Court for seeking clarification of the order impugned.

He is permitted to do so within a period of six weeks from today.

Interim protection is granted to the petitioner herein for a period of six weeks from today.

The special leave petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty and protection to the petitioner.

As a sequel to the above, pending interlocutory applications also stand disposed of.
