ORDER

1. Leave granted.
2. We have heard the learned counsels for the parties.
3. The report from the learned trial Court with regard to the stage of the trial against the accused appellant has not been furnished. However, the learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions, submits that only two prosecution witnesses are left to be examined and the learned trial Court has fixed 22nd February, 2017 as the next date.
4. In view of the fact that the trial is at the fag end we do not consider it

appropriate to pass orders releasing the accused appellant on bail. Instead, we are of the view that it will be more appropriate to direct the learned trial Court to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible and in any case on or before 30th June, 2017. We also make it clear that in the event the trial is not completed as per the aforesaid time frame it will be open for the appellant to renew his prayer for bail before the learned trial Court. We make it clear that we have expressed no opinion on the merits of the case.

5. With the aforesaid observation, the appeal is disposed of.
