O R D E R

We have heard Ms. Aishwarya Bhati, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner. On behalf of the respondent, we have also heard Mr. P.S. Datta, learned senior counsel appearing for the sole respondent, who is on caveat.

Issue notice.

Mr. Fuzail Ahmad Ayyubi, Adocate-On-Record, accepts notice on behalf of the sole respondent.

There shall be an interim stay of the impugned judgment on condition that the petitioner to pay maintenance amount of

Rs.20,000/- per month as an interim arrangement until further orders from this Court. Maintenance amount of Rs.20,000/- is payable on or before 7th day of every succeeding English calendar month. The petitioner shall also pay all the arrears at the rate of Rs.20,000/- per month.

Learned senior counsel appearing for the parties submit that the parties are not averse to exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement through the mediation.

We see no reason to decline an opportunity to the parties to do so. We accordingly refer the parties to the Mediation Centre in the Supreme Court with the direction that the parties shall appear before the Mediation Centre on Thursday, the 29th August, 2019 at 11:00 A.M.

When the respondent appears before the Mediation Centre, the petitioner shall pay the expenses of Rs.25,000/- directly to the respondent as traveling expenses.

Post the matter after the report is received from the Mediation Centre.
