The thrust of the argument pursued on behalf of the petitioners is that the High Court has completely glossed over the purport of Section 3 of the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006, which indisputably must apply to the petitioner-institution being an educational institution set up by the Central Government under the Society Registration Act, 1860.
