Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the Appellant has stated at the Bar that the main appeal (Criminal Appeal No. 202 of 2003 pending before the Delhi High Court), out of which the present proceedings arise, against an interim order passed by the High Court, suspending the conviction of the respondents-accused, has since been finally disposed of by the High Court, vide its judgment dated 9th December, 2009.
