Leave granted.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The trial court as well as the High Court allowed the application filed by the applicants under Order I Rule 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

In our opinion, the order passed on the application for impleadment does not require to be dealt with since there is no error in the order that has been passed by the High Court.

In so far as injunction which was existing is concerned, it is the submission of learned counsel for the appellant that the High Court was in error in vacating the injunction.

In our opinion, it would be appropriate if the parties may maintain status quo. We order accordingly. However, liberty is granted to all the parties to apply for modification of the *status quo* in accordance with law.

The civil appeals are disposed of.

Since the suit has been pending for quite some time, we are of

opinion that the trial court should take steps to try and expedite the disposal of the suit.

Learned counsel for the parties say that they will extend cooperation in the early disposal of the suit.
