O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and carefully perusing the material placed on record, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court dismissing the petition for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner herein.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that if interim protection for a period of two weeks is granted to the petitioner, she will surrender and file an application for regular bail before the trial court.

Accordingly, two weeks' time is granted to the petitioner to surrender and file an application for regular bail before the trial court.

If the petitioner surrenders and files an application for regular bail before the trial court within the time stipulated hereinabove, the same may be considered and disposed of by it in accordance with law expeditiously without being influenced by any of the observation made by the High Court.

For a period of two weeks from today, interim protection is granted to the petitioner herein.

The petitioner is directed to cooperate with the investigation at all stages. Additionally, interim protection is also subject to the compliance of other conditions, as enumerated in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
