O R D E R

The present petition has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in reference to FIR No. 73/2020 dated 10.07.2020 registered at Police Station Mahila Thana, District Udaipur, Rajasthan for

offence under Section 498A, 406 and 377 IPC which was declined by the High Court by order dated 24.09.2020.

We find that the High Court has neither appreciated nor recorded *prima facie* reasons while rejecting the bail application of the petitioner under the order impugned.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the material on record and without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the matter, we are of the view that the petitioner has made out a case for grant of pre-arrest bail.

Ordered accordingly.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- along with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Court, as the case may be.

It is informed that the investigation is still pending. Let the Investigating Officer may conclude the investigation and take further steps in accordance with law and the petitioner shall cooperate in the investigation.

With the aforesaid directions, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of accordingly.
