O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

This Court vide order dated 7-8-2020 while dismissing the Special Leave Petition, granted eight weeks' time to the petitioner to surrender and apply for regular bail and the Trial Court was also directed to dispose of the said application expeditiously on its own merits and in accordance with law.

Now, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner filed two Interlocutory Applications (i) bearing No.99142 of 2020 seeking direction to the SHO/IO of Police Station-Women N.I.T., Faridabad (Haryana) to allow the petitioner to join the investigation and undergo DNA Test in respect of FIR No.114 dated 12-7-2019 under Section 6 of POCSO Act and Section 506 of the Indian Penal Code and (ii) bearing No.99144 of 2020 seeing extension of four weeks' more time to surrender before the concerned Trial Court.

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and perusing the material available on record, we find no merit in the said Interlocutory Applications.

The Interlocutory Applications are, accordingly, dismissed. Miscellaneous Application also stands disposed of.
