We do not consider it appropriate to exercise our discretion in favour of the petitioner in view of the observations of the Sessions Court that he has been repeatedly involved in several crimes.

In these circumstances, we do not consider it appropriate to examine the contention that the First Information Report must contain a statement that the petitioner abused the respondent-complainant when he

was alone though two other witnesses claimed that they were present when he so abused. This is the matter for trial which is going on.

Accordingly, the special leave petition is dismissed.
