 O R D E R

Mr. Mukul Rohatgi, learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner argues that there are several dues owed to the petitioners, which have been caught up in litigation, and in one of them a contempt petition has been filed in this Court, in which

notice has been issued. Be that as it may, there is no direct link between those matters and this matter as a result of which the farmers have to be paid. We only extend the time for full payment of the arrears that is spoken about in the impugned judgment till 31.03.2021.

We record the statement of Mr. Mukul Rohatgi that his client has, in fact, paid a sum of Rs.50 Crores (approx.) till date. If the payment is made by 31.03.2021, the order of arresting the Directors will not come into force.

The Special Leave Petitions are disposed of in the above terms.

Pending applications also stand disposed of.
