O R D E R

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, we are not inclined to entertain this Special Leave Petition. The Special

Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner is in possession of the premises, we have requested to the learned counsel for the respondent(s) to pay a lumpsum amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only).

The learned counsel for the respondent(s), on instructions, of Shri Vikas Mishra, who is personally present in Court, states that the respondent(s) will pay the amount of Rs.10,00,000/- to the petitioner through demand draft at the time the petitioner vacates the premises.

He further states that on the petitioner vacating the premises after the time granted by this Court, the respondent(s) shall withdraw the criminal cases filed against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, we grant six months' time to the petitioner to vacate the premises, subject to his furnishing usual undertaking before this Court within four weeks from today, stating that neither the petitioner nor his family member(s) will create any third party rights and will peacefully vacate the premises concerned by the end of February, 2023.

It is further directed, on the date of which, the petitioner vacates the premises, the respondent(s) shall pay him a demand draft of Rs. 10,00,000/- and shall withdraw all

criminal proceedings filed against him within a period of four weeks from the date of vacating the premises.

Needless to state that any proceedings filed by the petitioner against the respondent(s) shall also be withdrawn with the aforesaid period.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
