In the facts and circumstances of the case, we consider it appropriate to direct that the compensation be enhanced to a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only).

Order accordingly.

We also direct that the interest amount will be payable only on the amount of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) as awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (for short, the Tribunal) and affirmed by the High Court .

Hence, the instant appeal is allowed and the order passed by the Tribunal as affirmed by the High Court is modified to the above extent.
