O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

Application seeking exemption from filing attested/notarized affidavit is allowed.

This Special Leave Petition is filed by the petitioner against the impugned order passed by the High Court rejecting the second bail application of the petitioner as not maintainable on the ground that this Court had earlier rejected the bail application on 18-6-2020 without giving liberty to the petitioner to revive the application before the High Court.

Now, the petitioner has sought liberty to file bail application before the concerned Trial Court and seeks an observation from this Court that the dismissal of the Special Leave Petition should not come in the way of consideration of his bail application by the concerned Trial Court.

In view of the above, we dispose of the Special Leave Petition with the observation that in case the petitioner applies for bail before the concerned Trial Court, the said Court is directed to dispose of the same taking into consideration the facts of the case, on its own merits and in accordance law, without being influenced by the dismissal of the Special Leave Petition by this Court on 18-6-2020.

Pending applications filed in the matter also stand disposed of.
