O R D E R

This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of M.C.No.4565 of 2016, titled as Guru Prasad V.S. vs. Neha Singh, pending before the Court of Principal Family Court Judge at Bengaluru, in the State of Karnataka, to the Family Court at Thane, in the State of Maharashtra.

The petitioner has sought transfer of the case mainly on the ground of financial difficulty and her inability to travel from Thane to Bengaluru, which is at a distance of more than 1000 km, leaving behind her four year's old daughter, to attend the proceedings of the case filed by the respondent.

Vide order dated 02.08.2019, the matter was referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre. Mediation Report dated 13.09.2019 has been received according to which the petitioner telephonically informed that she does not want to continue mediation. Hence the case is not fit for mediation.

In view of the hardships which will be faced by the petitioner in contesting the case at Bengaluru, Karnataka, we deem it proper to allow the transfer petition and direct transfer of M.C.No.4565 of 2016, titled as Guru Prasad V.S. vs. Neha Singh, pending before the Court of Principal Family Court Judge at Bengaluru, in the State of Karnataka, to the Family Court at Thane, in the State of Maharashtra, along with all records for its adjudication. Ordered accordingly.

After transfer of the petition, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavours either to consider amicable settlement, or render early decision in the matter without unnecessary adjournments.
