O R D E R

We have heard party in-person, K. Venkateswara Rao.

The petitioner-K.Venkateswara Rao alleges willful disobedience of order of this Court dated 17.07.2017 and also Order dated 03.11.2017 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Hyderabad.

By Order dated 17.07.2017, this Court has only directed the competent authority to consider the representation of the petitioner-K.Venkateswara Rao and pass orders within a period of six weeks from the date of the Order.

Admittedly, the Authorities have passed the order on 24.08.2017 and, therefore, we do not find any disobedience much

less willful disobedience of the Order of this Court so as to initiate contempt proceedings. However, if the petitioner is dissatisfied with the order dated 24.08.2017 he may assail the same in the appropriate proceedings.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of reserving liberty to the petitioner-K.Venkateswara Rao to challenge the said order dated 24.08.2017.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
