under:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are a couple aged 77 and 72 years and have already served 5-1/2 and 3 years respectively. The appeal is pending before the High Court. Learned counsel has drawn our attention to the findings in para 8 at page 18 and the statement of PW-15 at page 27 to contend that the petitioner No.1 was already at the police 1 station having lodged a cross FIR at the time when the alleged incident of *marpeet* has taken place. The dead body was found only subsequently and there is no eye witness to the incident as is apparent from page 41.”

In the given conspectus of the factual situation of the present case more so as noticed in the order dated

05.11.2020, we grant bail to the appellants on the terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The appeal is accordingly allowed.
