O R D E R

In compliance of our order dated 13-10-2017, the petitioner and the respondent have appeared before us today along with their respective learned counsel.

2. It appears that there was some interaction between the parties and their respective learned counsels and according to them, there is a possibility of amicable settlement of the disputes between the parties.

3. As regards the divorce case being H.M.A. No.269 of 2017 sought to be transferred by the petitioner (wife) in these Transfer Petitions, the respondent (husband) has expressed no objection if the said case is transferred from the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Shahdara, Karkardooma Courts, New Delhi to the Principle Judge, Family Court, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. Accordingly, we transfer the said case to the Principle Judge, Family Court, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. Let record of the case be transferred without delay.

4. However, before conducting proceedings in the Family Court, in view of the possibility of amicable settlement between the parties, we direct the parties to appear before the

Mediation and Conciliation Centre situated in the Lucknow Bench of the Allahabad High Court for amicable settlement of the dispute. The Mediation and Conciliation Centre shall make an effort to settle the disputes between the parties amicably and furnish its report to the Family Court, Lucknow.

5. The Transfer Petitions stand allowed in the afore-stated terms.
