UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Miscellaneous Application No.343 of 2017 has been filed challenging the order dated 10.04.2017 passed by the Registrar of this Court. The writ petition filed by the petitioner on 20.07.2016 had as many as 34 defects which were notified. Since the defects were not cured, the aforesaid order was passed by the Registrar declining to register the writ petition under the Supreme Court Rules.

Instead of going into the questions whether the defects were cured or not, we have taken up the writ petition itself for consideration.

The instant writ petition has been filed seeking relief in the nature of compensation in the sum of Rs. 2 crores from State of Punjab for destroying the evidence of gang-rape and for certain other reliefs.

It is a matter of record that an appeal filed by the petitioner being CRA-AD-373 of 2019 is presently pending consideration before the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh and the next date of hearing is 15.03.2021.

The basic issue which the petitioner is seeking to highlight will be gone into and assessment on merits will be done in said CRA-AD-373 of 2019. At this stage it will, therefore, be premature to consider the prayer for compensation.

We, therefore, see no reason to keep this writ petition

pending on the file of this Court. The writ petition is disposed of.

It is made clear that CRA-AD-373 of 2019 will be considered on its own merits without being influenced by the rejection of this writ petition.

The writ petition and Miscellaneous Application No.343 of 2017 are disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
