UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

By an order dated 8.5.2019, the application filed for anticipatory bail by the petitioners was dismissed. However, eight weeks' time was granted to the petitioners to surrender before the Trial Court.

An application is moved by the petitioners seeking extension of time for surrendering by another four weeks. The first petitioner relies upon certain documents to submit that his mother is seriously ill

and he needs to be with her for some more time till she is discharged from the hospital.

The petitioner No.2 has stated in the application that he has an aged father who is 84 years age and is suffering from illness and he requires four more weeks for surrendering.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we extend the time by four weeks to surrender only to petitioner No.1, in view of the serious ill-health of his mother.

The application qua petitioner No.2 is rejected.

M.A. stands disposed of, accordingly.
