Petitioner was convicted and sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for life by the Trial Court for the offences punishable under Sections 120B, 341, 324 & 302 r/w Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short "the IPC") which has been upheld by the High Court except under Section 120B of the IPC.

We do not think it is a case which calls for our interference, in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India as the prosecution has been able to prove its case beyond reasonable doubt.
