**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

1. Against an order rejecting the regular bail by the High Court and to seek bail, the present special leave petition has been filed. The petitioner is in custody w.e.f. 06.07.2023 in connection with FIR No. 126 dated 19.06.2023 for the offences punishable under Sections 395, 397, 412, 120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act

registered with Police Station Bandra, District Howrah, West Bengal.

2. Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and taking note of the fact that the present petitioner has not been identified in the Test Identification Parade, out of 30 witnesses, only 04 witnesses have been examined and the period of incarceration which is more than one year and eleven months, therefore, at this stage, we are inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

3. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing the suitable bail bonds and sureties and on such other terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the trial Court.

4. Petitioner to abide all the conditions as imposed and shall regularly attend the trial until exempted by the Court. Violation, if any, may give a cause to take recourse as permissible and the trial Court is at liberty to do the needful.

5. Accordingly and in view of the foregoing, the special leave petition stands allowed.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
